Good morning its February 22 my name is Wayne Moore, Neil Johnson for Josh Moody.

NEIL JOHNSON: Josh, I had a picture of you with a little baby, and the Lord reminded me how is to have a newborn, that they are constantly demanding and where they have a need they let you know about it right away. And then they won't stop unless you've met that need. Their insistence, they're demanding and they won't relent no matter what time of the day it is. I don't get frustrated I don't get frustrated I always have the answer and I'm constantly there waiting for you to call in my name, to seek me. You can't frustrate me. You can't ask me an answer or to solve problem that I can't solve it for you, and I was reminded of a chapter that the Lord brought to my attention a little earlier is in Isaiah 65 and the Lord says” I was ready to respond but no one asked for help. I was ready to be found but no one looked for me. I said here I am, here I am.” And I felt like the Lord was saying to you this morning that those, those areas those questions that you have that the Lord was saying, “Josh come and pursue me seek me out, try and suck the life out of me - you won't be able to do it, but seek me because I'm going to be the answer for you I will answer your needs.

WAYNE MOORE: I say what I saw I saw you sitting on a cycle machine kind of spinning your wheels I think the Lord wants you to know that you're in a very gifted place this time it may seem like your on a stationary object going nowhere but really you're being worked out, condition and in shape to do a greater work. And it is not anything to be looked upon lightly that it may not feel like you're going and accomplishing a lot of things at this time in your life that you thought you would have prepared or planned out.

I don't know if you're married or have children or not or anything but I got the word restoration which is maybe something just to hang on to, but God is going to restore something back into your life it may not be an individual person it may be something else but I did hear the word restoration and is coming back in your favor but in this cyclical cross process of this going going gone we get bored and tired and we don't know what its purpose is an all of a sudden these muscles get strengthened up and its endurance gets better all of a sudden man you're taken control to them saying and I believe that got schedule in a place not to be just ran past - in other words a lot of time that pain is there and we waste it. Because we don't take out of that situation what we really need to learn and I completely agree with Neil I think it goes hand-in-hand that you're not going to exhaust the hand of God the blessings and the grace of God.

RECIPIENT: Josh Moody: that is, that's a really good word for me, because I don't, I tend to rely on myself too much and not on God. I got laid off the end of January so were going through the process of trying to find a job, trying to find where I fit where I belong now.
